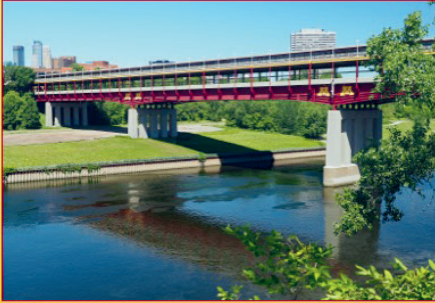


I remember

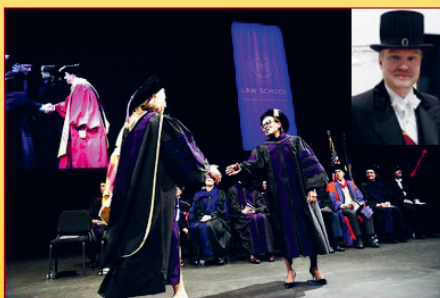
